Sub: Estt - Filling up of post of Intelligence Officers on deputation in
DRI, Chennai, Hyderabad, Visakhapatnam & Tuticorin - Willingness
Called for - Reg.

The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence, Chennai Zonal unit is in the process of drawing a panel of suitable candidates for filling up the vacancies in the cadre of Intelligence Officers in the pay scale of Rs.9300-34800 + Grade pay of Rs.4600/4800 at, DRI, Chennai, and its Regional Units at Hyderabad, Visakhapatnam and Tuticorin which are likely to arise during this year.

2. The posts are to be filled up is on deputation basis and the minimum qualifying service prescribed is three years which may be relaxed in deserving cases by the Directorate. Normally, the deputation is for a period of 5 years which is extendable by another two years subject to the willingness of the officer, his/her performance, and the concurrence of the parent formation.

3. The selected officers while working in the Directorate in the grade of Intelligence Officer, will be entitled for a special pay of 10% of the basic pay as defined in FR 9(21)(a)(I) in the revised pay scale subject to the prescribed ceiling of Rs.2000/- per month and they have to make their own arrangements for residential accommodation.

4. It is requested that the circular may be brought to the notice of all the formations in your jurisdiction and the applications of willing officers may be forwarded to this office along with a bio-data of the officer denoting date of birth, date of superannuation, date of appointment to the

present cadre, the history sheet of postings and experience in detecting cases and effecting seizures.

5. Further, as per para IV of Ministry's F.No. A-35017/28/92 AD.IIIB dated 30.06.1994 officers posted in certain charges/organizations/assignments are required to complete the "cooling off period" of not less than two years before posting in Directorate of Revenue Intelligence. However, the concerned Chief Commissioner of Customs/Central Excise has been given the power to relax the "Cooling Off" period.

6. While forwarding the willingness the following particulars may also be given by the Commissionerate:

- i) Attested copy of CCR grading for the last 10 years or less if service is less;
- ii) History of posting for the past 10 years or less if total service is less;
- iii) Anti-smuggling experience with details of seizures effected;
- iv) Vigilance clearance and history of any post vigilance cases;
- v) Willingness of the officer;
- vi) No objection certificate from the Commissioner to relive the officer in the event of selection;
- vii) Place of Choice i.e. (CHENNAI/HYDERABAD/VISAKHAPATNAM/TUTICORIN)
