Sub: Option to avail Section 49 facility during the COVID-19 crisis period-reg

Attention of the Importers, Exporters, Custom Brokers, General Trade, Airlines and all other stakeholders is invited to provisions of Section 49 of Customs Act, 1962 wherein it is provided as follows:

Where,—

(a) in the case of any imported goods, whether dutiable or not, entered for home consumption, the Assistant Commissioner of Customs or Deputy Commissioner of Customs is satisfied on the application of the importer that the goods cannot be cleared within a reasonable time;

(b) in the case of any imported dutiable goods, entered for warehousing, the Assistant Commissioner of Customs or Deputy Commissioner of Customs is satisfied on the application of the importer that the goods cannot be removed for deposit in a warehouse within a reasonable time;


the goods may pending clearance or removal, as the case may be, be permitted to be stored in a public warehouse for a period not exceeding thirty days:

2. In the present period of crisis, if any importers who have filed the Bill of Entry are not in a position to clear the cargo they may avail this option to avoid demurrage and custodian charges and move the cargo temporarily to a CONCOR Public Warehouse which reportedly has enough space for an initial period of 30 days which may be extended by another 30days.

3. All the Trade/Importers are advised to make use of this option. You may send an email to Shri. Anurag Rai, Deputy Commissioner, on his email anurag.rai@gov.in, to avail this option. CONCOR have also been suitably advised to extend the facility of warehousing under Section 49 to all importers on first-come-first-serve basis till the space is available.

4. Action to be taken in terms of decisions taken in this Public Notice will be considered as Standing Order for the purpose of officers/staff.
