

## Public Notice No.02 /2022 - Bengaluru Customs Zone

Reference is invited to the office Public Notice No 13/2020 dated 11.09.2020 issued by this office. Reference may also be made to Circular Nos. 45/2020-Customs dated 12.10.2020, 55/2020-Customs dated 17.12.2020, and 14 /2021-Customs dated 07.07.2021 issued by Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs regarding the roll out of Faceless Assessment pan India w.e.f. 31.10.2020 and further clarification/ streamlining of certain processes for effective implementation of Faceless Assessment.
