Sub: Request for Amendments and Waiver of Late Fee Charges in the Bills of Entry through e-mail procedure as facilitation during outbreak of COVID-19-reg

Attention of the importers, exporters, Customs Brokers and all other stakeholders is invited to the above cited subject.

2. In order to ensure social distancing and to minimize the physical human contact during the period of restrictions on account of the threat of the nCovid-19, it is decided that the applications requesting for the amendments in terms of the Sec. 149 of the Customs Act 1962 and for waiver of late fee (waived vide PN No: 03/2020 of CCO , B'lore Cus Zone) on account of the delay in filing bills of entry can be made by sending email to specified official email IDs as follows-

3. The above email IDs are of Deputy/Asst. Commissioners of Customs. In case they are temporarily working from home, they will immediately convey to the concerned DC/AC in office. The concerned officers will act upon the requests received through such email and keep the hard copies of the same as record in the respective group.

4. A copy of all such email requests shall be endorsed by the Trade to Shri Naresh G, Joint Commissioner, ICD on email id: naresh.irs61@gov.in , who shall monitor the disposal of such requests, on priority.

5. The applications for the amendments would be examined by the competent authority and decide the matter as per the relevant provisions of the law and the procedure prescribed. The decision in this regard would also be communicated by return mail to the concerned.

6. Action to be taken in terms of decisions taken in this Public Notice will be considered as Standing Order for the purpose of officers/staff.
