Sub: - Non-receipt of Export remittance data from EDPMS developed by RBI — reg.

Attention of the exporters and Authorised Dealer (AD) Banks are invited to the above cited subject.

2. It is for the information that the data in the RBI BRC (RBI-MIS Reports) shows that foreign exchange realization in respect of a large number of shipping bills of INWFD6 are pending. This is because of not uploading the realization data by the AD Banks and regular follow up by the exporters. The exporters are once again reminded to check BRC integration status with Customs using the ICEGATE enquiry module and to follow up with the authorized dealer bank to get the information transmitted to the portal of RBI (EDPMS).

3. It is further brought to the notice of the exporters that the pendency has to be followed with AD Banks and complete the updation within a period of 30 days. The exporters are informed that in case of any pendency, after the due date, an alert will be made in the ICEGATE, which will be followed by the issue of SCN and adjudication proceedings. The list of shipping bills is available on the website www.bangalorecustoms.gov.in.

4. The BRC Cell of Customs ICD Whitefield would monitor the realization of export proceeds for the shipping bills, with LEO dated on or after 01.04.2014, under the new RBI-BRC module and would stop accepting/acknowledging 6 monthly negative statement from authorized dealers/chartered accountants showing the proof of realization of export proceeds (BRC). In all such cases of non-realisation of export proceeds recovery action under provisions of Section 75(1) of the Customs Act, 1962 read with Rule 18 of the Customs and Central Excise Duties Drawback Rules, 2017 will be initiated against the erring exporter.

5. However, shipping bills whose LEO was granted before 01.04.2014 would continue to be dealt in terms of provisions of Public Notice No. 07/2016 dated 05.02.2016 read with Board's Circular No. 5/2009-cus dated 02.02.2009.

6. Any difficulties in implementation of the above procedure may be brought to the notice of the Joint Commissioner of Customs, ICD Whitefield, Bengaluru.
