Subject:- Customs: ICES Advisory 38/2020-Enhancement in ICES and certain clarifications in respect of Faceless Assessment-reg.

1. Attention of the Trade/Importers/Exporters/Custom Brokers is invited to **ICES Advisory 38/2020 dated 14.10.2020** (enclosed for reference) in respect of Faceless Assessment. Reference is invited to the ICES Advisory No. 32/2020 dated 13.09.2020 describing therein the various facets of Faceless Assessment in ICES. In this regard, various additional features have been enabled in ICES in order to further streamline the assessment process. In addition, certain clarifications are being provided herewith for more clarity.

2. The enhancements are as stated below.

(A) Enhancements in ICES

- 1) Option to have multiple VDCs for the same group at an FAG site
- 2) Masking of SSO ID of the Customs officer
- 3) Identification of Bills of Entry filed by AEO
- 4) Limit on setting aside of Bills of Entry by VDC
- 5) Enhancements in the Dashboards for NAC and Reports for VAO and VDC
- 6) SMS Alerts to VAO/VDC

(B) Clarifications in respect of certain issues

- (1) Filing amendment for adding Supporting Docs to a Bill of Entry (For further clarifications, the trade may refer to ICES Advisory at URL- [https://www.icegate.gov.in/Download/ICES Advisory 35 2020 on amendment and query reply with supp docs v2.pdf](https://www.icegate.gov.in/Download/ICES_Advisory_35_2020_on_amendment_and_query_reply_with_supp_docs_v2.pdf))
- (2) Updating the actual percentage of Bank Guarantee (BG) during license/bond registration. Difficulties faced, if any, may be emailed to saksham.seva@icegate.gov.in and a copy be marked to team.ices@icegate.gov.in.
