Subject :- Publication of New (Seventh) Edition of the Harmonized System Of Nomenclature, HS – 2022 – reg

Attention of Importers, Exporter, Customs Brokers, Trade Bodies and all officers is invited to the above captioned subject.

- 2. The WCO Convention on Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (the HS convention) came out with the Harmonised System (HS) Nomenclature in order to facilitate the standardization of trade documentation and the transmission of data. The HS nomenclature forms the basis of national Customs Tariff of over 200 nations, including India.
- 3. As India is the part of HS Convention, necessary changes were brought in accordingly, through the Fifth Schedule to the Finance Act, 2021 in order to align the First Schedule of the Customs Tariff Act, 1975 with the HS 2022 which came into effect from 01.01.2022.
- 4. This edition has introduced some significant changes to the Harmonized System with a total of 351 of amendments at the six-digit level, covering a wide range of goods moving across borders.
