Public Notice No. 27/2025

M/s. Mangaluru International Airport Limited, Mangaluru ('MgIAL' for short) was approved vide Public Notice No. 02/2023 dated 14.12.2023, as Custodian of cargo to be imported at Mangaluru International Airport for the purpose of safe custody at Integrated Cargo Terminal ('ICT' for short), Mangaluru International Airport until the goods are cleared for home consumption or for warehousing or for transshipment under Regulation 10(1) of the Handling of Cargo in Customs Area Regulations, 2009 ('HCCAR, 2009') and Section 45(1) of the Customs Act, 1962 and appointed as a Customs Cargo Service Provider ('CCSP') for custody of imported or export goods and for handling of such goods in a customs area in accordance with the provisions laid down under the Customs Act, 1962.

2. MgIAL vide letter Ref No. MgIAL/Cargo/CCSP/2025-26/4131 dated 01.12.2025, have furnished an application in Form-A as prescribed under Regulation 9(1) of HCCAR, 2009, for approval and renewal of the custodianship of cargo to be imported at Mangaluru International Airport and CCSP for custody of imported or export goods. The custodian has executed requisite Import/Export Bonds and Bank Guarantees as per Regulation 5(3) of HCCAR regulations 2009. Further the custodian has also furnished a Trans-shipment Bond and Bank Guarantee as per Regulation 5(4) of HCCAR regulations 2009. The said Bank Guarantees are provided with the auto renewal clause. The custodian has furnished General Insurance Policy as required under Circular No. 42/2016-Customs dated 31.08.2016.

3. In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 45(1) of the Customs Act, 1962 read with HCCAR, 2009, the custodianship of M/s. Mangaluru International Airport Ltd. is hereby extended for FIVE YEARS from the date of issue of this public notice, as per the provisions of Regulation 10(2) and 10(3) of the HCCAR, 2009 or until further orders, whichever is earlier and extend the appointment of M/s.Mangaluru International Airport Ltd., as a Customs Cargo Service Provider for custody of imported or export goods and for handling of such goods in a customs area in accordance with the provisions laid down under the Customs Act read with relevant laws, rules, regulations, notifications, instructions and circulars, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The Custodian/CCSP shall comply with all provisions of Customs Act, 1962 and any other Laws, Rules and Regulations, Notifications, Instructions, Circulars, Public Notices for the time being in force; that is being enforced by

Customs and are applicable to Customs Cargo Service Provider/Custodian of goods/cargo in Customs Area.

- (b) The Custodian/CCSP shall fulfill all the conditions and responsibilities and comply with all the regulations laid down in Handling of Cargo in Customs Area Regulations, 2009 issued under Section 45(1) and 141(2) of the Customs Act, 1962 by the Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Revenue, Central Board of Excise & Customs, New Delhi, as amended from time to time.
- (c) The Custodian/CCSP shall pay to the Government or the proper officer, any amount of Customs Duty payable on the imported goods pilfered or not accounted for, as per Section 45(3) of the Customs Act, 1962.
- (d) The Custodian/CCSP shall get insured all the goods (imported/export) held in the Customs Area at Integrated Cargo Terminal, Mangaluru International Airport, Mangaluru, against all kinds of risks. The amount of insurance to be provided by CCSP should be equal to the average value of goods likely to be stored in the Customs area for a period of 30 days (based on projected capacity).
- (e) The Custodian/CCSP shall bear the cost of the Customs Officers posted, at such Customs Area, on cost recovery basis, by the Commissioner and shall make payments at such rates and in advance of at least three months, unless specifically exempted by an order of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance.
- (f) The Custodian/CCSP shall not lease, gift, sell or sublet or in any other manner transfer any of the premises in a customs area; or sub contract or outsource functions permitted or required to be carried out by them in terms of HCCAR, 2009 to any other person/organization, without the written permission of the Commissioner of Customs.
- (g) The Custodian/CCSP shall publish and display at prominent places including website or webpage of the Custodian/CCSP, the schedule of charges for the various services provided by them/him, in relation to the imported goods or export goods in the Customs Area.
- (h) The Custodian/CCSP shall provide infrastructure, equipment and adequate manpower for loading, unloading, stacking, handling, stuffing and de-stuffing of containers, storage, dispatch and delivery of containers and cargo, etc., to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Customs, Mangaluru. The Custodian/CCSP shall provide safe, secure and spacious premises for loading, unloading, handling and storing of the cargo for the projected capacity and for the examination and other operations as may be required in compliance with any law for the time being in force.
- (i) The Custodian/CCSP shall keep a record of imported goods, goods brought for export or transshipment, as the case may be and produce the same to the proper officer as and when required and shall not permit imported goods and export goods to be removed from the port premises of Integrated Cargo Terminal, Mangaluru International Airport or otherwise dealt with except under and in accordance with the permission in writing of the proper officer of Customs, Integrated Cargo Terminal. The Custodian/CCSP shall keep a record of each activity or action taken in relation to the movement or handling of imported or export goods and goods brought for transshipment.
- (j) The Custodian/CCSP shall fulfill all the conditions specified in Regulation 5 of the HCCAR, 2009 (as amended from time to time) and shall discharge

their responsibilities promptly and effectively as specified in Regulation 6 of the HCCAR, 2009 (as amended from time to time).

- (k) The Custodian/CCSP shall not make any alteration of the plan in the accommodation, boundary wall, building, etc., without the concurrence of the Commissioner of Customs, Mangaluru.

4. The goods shall be stored in the areas as specified in Notification No.01/2023-Customs, Mangaluru dtd.12.12.2023 (Copy enclosed).

5. The approval given is without prejudice to cancellation for contravention of any expressly stated provisions or other relevant provisions.
